Call to Order

Chair Bolt called the meeting to order at 10:14 a.m. at the Road Commission of Kalamazoo County

Election of Officers

MOTION by Arver, Supported by Welch "to nominate Ryan Minkus as Chair." Motion passed.

Minkus assumed duties as Chair upon completion of the vote.

MOTION by Arver, Supported by Welch "to nominate the St. Joseph County representative as Vice Chair." Motion Passed.

Approval of June 20, 2016 Rural Task Force 3# Meeting Minutes

No comments or changes were offered to the draft minutes of the June 20, 2016 minutes.

MOTION by Welch, SUPPORT by Arver, "to approve the June 20, 2016 Rural Task Force #3 Minutes as presented." Motion passed.

Review of 2017 Projects and Target Balances

Nagler presented a spreadsheet summarizing the current approved programming amounts for each county and the remaining unallocated target amount resulting from previous Task Force actions and recently released 2017 federal STL and state EDD targets.

Discussion ensued regarding how best to allocate the remaining un-programmed target allocation of \$553,713.

Minkus suggested that that previously approved illustrative projects be moved into the 2017 program to utilize the remaining obligation authority

Welch said that as previous adjustments in allocation were made to each county's target at the same ratio as MDOT target allocations, he believed that the remaining Task Force unprogrammed balance should be distributed in the same manner.

Kline reminded the group that in previous adjustments, Kalamazoo County was not given allocation increases and that after the last adjustments, the Task Force considered the remaining counties as having been made whole. Therefore, she didn't believe that Kalamazoo County should be excluded from increases during this round of adjustment.

A review of the previous redistribution of 2018 target allocations was also undertaken.

MOTION by Arver, SUPPORT by Bolt "to distribute the region's total unprogrammed target allocation of federal STL funding to each county at the same ratio as used in the Michigan Department of Transportation allocations. Motion passed on 4 to 1 with Barry voting against.

After the motion and before the vote there was further discussion. Welch stated that he felt since Barry County's unprogrammed amount of target allocation so high relative to the other counties that in his view Barry would not be receiving a fair amount of the increase.

Subsequent to the vote and more discussion, Barry requested that their vote be changed to supporting the previous motion.

Attention turned to addressing the over-programming of state EDD funding.

MOTION by Myland "to reduce each county's approved 2017 EDD target allocation at the same ratio of the total over-programming as used in the Michigan Department of Transportation allocations."

Discussion ensued regarding the fact that two Kalamazoo and Branch Counties have no approved EDD allocation for 2017 and cannot have a negative target.

AMMENDED MOTION by Myland, SUPPORT by Welch "to reduce each county's approved 2017 EDD target allocation as previously proposed, to distribute the negative balance for Kalamazoo and Branch evenly among Barry, Calhoun and St. Joseph and to reallocate approved EDD target balances from Kalamazoo and Branch in the same amounts to pay back those counties in 2018." Motion passed.

Because he had to leave shortly, Bolt requested that the meeting skip to item VII A.

Other Business: Local-Federal Fund Exchange

Arver said that Branch County has been in discussions with other counties regarding the exchange of allocated federal funding for local funding. He has been in touch with the County Road Association and MDOT and has been told that approval of the Rural Task Force Oversight Board is not required if such an exchange is made within Task Forces — only Task Force approval is required. Branch would like to exchange their entire programmed amounts with Calhoun for 2017 through 2020.

It was suggested that it might be difficult to approve the transfer for out years since it is likely that there will be adjustments to those years' target allocations in the future.

MOTION by Arver, SUPPORT by Myland "to approve the transfer of Branch County's Region Approved STL Target amount to County for 2017." Motion Carried

MOTION by Arver, SUPPORT by Welch "to approve the removal of Branch County's STL projects from the 2017 TIP." Motion Passed

Discussion returned to 2017 Projects

MOTION by Welch, SUPPORT by Kline "to approve changes made by each county, within 30 days of receipt of revised program summaries from KATS, in excess of 25% to each county's 2017 program to match new Region Approved Target amounts." Motion passed.

Updates of 2018 - 2020 Projects

MOTION by Welch, SUPPORT by KLINE "to approve changes made by each county, within 30 days of receipt of revised program summaries from KATS, in excess of 25% to each county's 2018 through 2020 programs to match new Region Approved Target amounts." Motion passed.

Rural Task Force #3

ARTICLE I-NAME

The name of this Task Force shall be the "Rural Task Force #3".

ARTICLE II-PURPOSE

The Rural Task Force Program provides federal and state dollars by region to rural counties with a population under 400,000 (78 out of 83 counties in Michigan). These dollars must be spent within the Region, comprised of Barry, Branch, Calhoun, Kalamazoo, and St. Joseph Counties. Road and transit capital projects are eligible.

The money is provided within two funding sources:

- 1. Surface Transportation Program (STP) Rural for improving the federal aid system and rural transit; and
- 2. State TEDF Category D for building and maintaining all-season Network

All final project selection is through the Rural Task Force which is comprised of equal representation from the five County Sub-Task Forces within the Region; Barry, Branch, Calhoun, Kalamazoo, and St. Joseph.

I. Project Location

- a. Projects shall be located on roads that have been functionally classified as a rural major collector or higher according to the National Functional Classification System approved by the Federal Highway Administration or;
- b. A Federal Transit Administration recognized rural transit provider within the Region.
- **c.** Money can be spent on rural minor collectors at the Michigan Department of Transportation's discretion.

II. Compliance

a. Projects shall be in compliance with all Federal and/or State standards unless waived by the agency having authority to do so.

III. Funding Sources/Matching/Requirements

- a. **STP-Rural** money can only be spent on "construction costs" and "contingencies" for highway projects. Right-of-way (ROW), construction engineering (CE), and preliminary engineering (PE) costs are a local responsibility, unless they are waived by the Rural Task Force #3. Requires at least a 20% non-federal match. This could be either State TEDF Category D or local match.
 - i. Transit capital projects are also eligible for STP funds.

b. State TEDF Category D

- i. Road must be classified as rural primary or higher
- ii. The road also must be designated as a "D" route by the appropriate County Sub-Task Force
- iii. TEDF-Category D projects must be funded with at least 20 percent of the cost coming from a non-TEDF source (i.e., STP-Rural, local, etc.) This stipulation can be waived by the Michigan Department of Transportation Office of Economic Development if the county or city can prove economic hardship.

ARTICLE III-MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the Rural Task Force shall consist of six (6) members. The membership shall include a (1) representative from each County Sub-Task Force and a (1) representative from MDOT. MDOT will vote on projects that utilize D funds.

Each member may have an alternate designated by the County Sub-Task Force which they represent, who shall have all the powers and privileges of the member in the absence of the member. The alternate is welcome to attend all meetings and enter into the discussions, but has no vote except in the absence of the member. Proxy votes will not be allowed.

ARTICLE IV-MEETINGS

All meetings will adhere to the Michigan Open Meetings Act and adhere to a Public Participation Plan.

- I. Regular meetings
 - **a.** Regular meetings of the Rural Task Force #3 shall be held between October and December of each year at a time and place to be determined by the chairman of the Task Force.
 - **b.** An annual April meeting will be held to determine the status of current fiscal year projects.
- II. Special meetings
 - a. Special meetings of the Rural Task Force #3 shall be held at the call of the chairman or at a written request of a majority of the members of the Task Force. Notification of the meeting to the member of the Task Force and the public will meet the standards of the Michigan Open Meeting Act.
- III. Public Participation and Meeting Notice
 - **a.** Notice of all regular meetings shall be given to each member by e-mail ten (10) days prior to the meeting date. Notice of special meetings may be given by telephone or by e-mail, which must state purpose of the meeting.
 - b. Transportation needs of Indian Tribal Government having jurisdiction over lands within the boundaries of the Task Force are considered during the process.
 - c. Include and encourage public involvement in the project selection process.
- IV. Quorum
 - **a.** A simple majority of the members of the Task Force shall constitute a quorum. Alternate members present in the absence of regular members shall be counted in determining a quorum.
- V. Minutes
 - **a.** Minutes shall be taken and provided to each member and the public by the Regional Planning Agency representative.

ARTICLE V-OFFICERS

The officers of the Rural Task Force #3 shall be a chairperson and vice-chairperson. The officers shall serve two (2) year terms. Elections are to be held between at a Regular Meeting on odd numbered years. The chairperson shall have the right to appoint committees.

ARTICLE VI-AMEND ARTICLES

The Task Force shall have power to make, alter, amend or repeal the Articles by a majority of the total membership voting in the affirmative at any regular or special meeting. A written notice of intention to make changes, including proposed changes, shall be presented to the membership prior to the meeting.
