Discussion/Action on Projects for Fiscal Years 2023 – 2026

Tate said that after performing design engineering and estimating on the City's Grand Street project, currently programmed for 2023, it is apparent that the cost will exceed the available budget. As an alternative City has identified a portion of W. State Street that is in need of rehabilitation, the execution of which can be done withing the existing budget.

After a brief discussion of the history of project prioritization in the Hastings Small Urban area, MOTION by Welch, SUPPORT by Voigt ***“to approve replacing the 2023 Hastings Grand Street project with a project to mill and resurface W. State Road from Glenwood to Broadway.”*** Motion passed unanimously.
